SMCI Announces Inaugural Awardees of Lillie/Donnelly Seed Grants to Improve Child and Maternal Health

Thanks to a generous gift from Altos Ventures in honor of John Lillie and Lane Donnelly, SMCI is pleased to announce the awardees of seed grants to improve child and maternal health. Six awardees were selected after a rigorous multi-layered review process.



The two awardees at the Silver Level (up to \$15K) are:

- Increasing Access to Bladder Bootcamp health education for Spanish speaking families: Principal Investigator: Kathleen Kan
- Advanced Inclusive Communication Training: Principal Investigator: Christy Sandborg



The four awardees at the Gold Level (up to 50k) are:

- Implementation of the POKE Score Tool to reduce unnecessary painful procedures in the NICU: Principal Investigator: Lisa Bain
- Presence 5 for Racial Justice-Pediatrics: Educating a novel curriculum to disseminate anti-racism practices for improvement in pediatric care: Principal Investigator: Baraka Floyd
- Partnered Needs Assessment to understand current patterns of perinatal LPCH to San Mateo County WIC referrals to inform future improvements: Principal Investigator: Jonathan G. Shaw
- A Biopsychosocial Model of Care in Pediatric Orthopedic Spine Clinics: Principal Investigator: Kali Tileston

SMCI is grateful to Dr. Stephen Roth who skillfully managed this grantee selection process with the superb assistance of Kim Stern from the Maternal and Child Health Research Institute (MCHRI).
